ELIGIBLE APPLICANTS MUST MEET THE FOLLOWING REQUIREMENTS:

- Submit a **current resume** (including any volunteer work or extracurriculars).
- Submit a **copy of transcripts** from all 4 years of high school.
- Preferred overall grade point average of 80 or above.
 - PLEASE NOTE: If you have struggled academically, you WILL NOT be disqualified. You may submit a written explanation (250 words or less) of any challenges you have faced and how you have overcome them.
- Submit a **written essay** (minimum of 500 words)—*pick **ONE** of the prompts below.*
 - Who is someone in your life who has inspired you to continue reaching for the best version of yourself? What does that "best version" mean to you?
 - How will you use this scholarship to further your academic endeavors? How do you intend to utilize what you learn in college within your community?
- **OPTIONAL**—Submit a letter of recommendation.
 - This should be a letter from a coach, mentor, or teacher who can speak in detail about your service to the community, your dedication to extracurricular activities, your commitment to your academics, and/or any perseverance you've demonstrated in your life and on your journey of personal growth.
